Church Life: Donna Klinger reported on upcoming fund-raisers.

Property and Maintenance: John Flory is getting estimates for new sidewalks and for costs related to repair/replace lighting on the cross in the Sanctuary.

Stewardship and Finance: Kim Flory gave a written report from a Zoom meeting held on April 6 attended by Kim Flory, Burt Hunt, Dean Fernsler, Joan Clark, David Rossetti. Pam Evans and John Flory were guests at this meeting.

Worship and Music: 1) Kathy Keath stated that work is being done on microphones in the Sanctuary that are not working well. Also, there is trouble hearing from lecterns on the live stream. 2) May services will include Mother's Day and Memorial Day/Trinity Sunday. 3) On a Friday evening to be determined a group by the name of "Piercing Word" will perform Parables of Jesus outside if the weather is warm. A free will offering will be taken. Consistory approved this.
